 - O Discussion focused on water conservation. Mrs. Penny encouraged residents to take advantage of the "toilet rebate program" that replaces up to 3 toilets in homes that were built prior to 1993. Also, the county will be expanding the waste water treatment plants. Residents should read the copy of "Water Matters" newsletter in their water bill for updates on upcoming projects and important information. - Presentation by Mr. Damon Johnson Public Outreach Director for the Dept of Public Works
 - O The increase in litter has resulted in an increase in storm water pollution. Mr. Johnson encouraged utilization of the county's recycling program to decrease storm water pollution especially by non-biodegradable trash such as plastic bottles, bags, etc. that travel from storm drains to our creeks and eventually to the Chattahoochee River, Georgia's source for drinking water. The program cost only \$30.00 which pays for the recycling bin and 100 blue recycling bags. He and Mrs. Penny joined the program over a year ago and still have not used all of their bags, thus the initial expense definitely outweighs the benefits.
